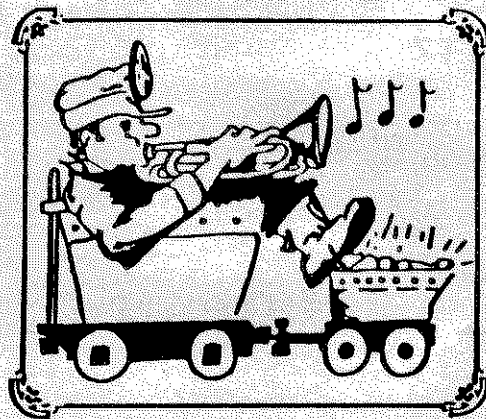

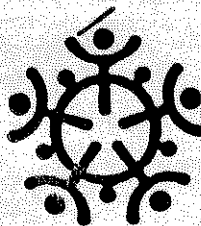

This year's concert features Renaissance and Baroque music, presented by soprano Beverly Marks, guitarist Lou Johnson, cellist Martha Brown, and the Village Festival Recorder Consort. Program numbers include the Bach-Gounod "Ave Maria" and three movements from Bach's Third Suite for unaccompanied cello. The Italian and English Renaissance music for recorders, soprano, and guitar, while largely unfamiliar to today's audiences, is charming and well-suited to be performed in an intimate setting.

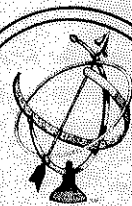
