## — Some History —

*The Nevada County Concert Band* is a direct descendant of the many local concert bands of the past century, which played for socials, county fairs, patriotic celebrations and Sunday afternoon concerts. In the early 1920's many of the local groups were consolidated into the Grass Valley Concert Band, through the efforts of Harold J. George, a renowned cornet player and musical director. The Band reorganized into its present form in 1972, and has been designated the Official Concert Band of Nevada County by the board of supervisors. The highlight of the Band's season is the summer picnic concert series in Nevada City — the Pioneer Park Picnic Pops. The spirit with which today's band members devote their talent and energies to rehearsals and performances is reflected in the enjoyment they receive and the enjoyment they bring to the local communities.

*The Sierra Community Symphony* was formed in 1978 by William Barnhart and Joseph Andre, Jr., members of the Nevada County Concert Band. It was felt there was a need for an orchestra whose members would be culled from the local communities. Originally called the Sierra Philharmonic, then the Sierra Community Orchestra, last year the orchestra took its present name: the Sierra Community Symphony. Sierra Musical Arts Association was organized at the beginning of the Symphony's founding and Sierra College became a joint sponsor shortly thereafter. A year ago, our present Conductor and Musical Director, Eugenio Gaddini, was hired. Mr. Gaddini has brought a wealth of musical expertise as well as inspiration to the group. It is his goal to improve the quality of the orchestra without letting go of the community spirit and to provide opportunities for non-professional musicians to perform.

*Sierra Musical Arts Association*, a non-profit organization, sponsors the Nevada County Concert Band, the Sierra Community Symphony, as well as the Sierra Youth Orchestra. 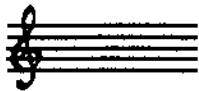
