Our concert today is dedicated to Mrs. Hulda Kopp Stern and the Emil Stern Music Scholarship Fund. Hulda established this fund in 1989 in memory of her husband Emil, who was a long-time member of the Nevada County Concert Band. He was known for his love and encouragement of young musicians in the band. The Scholarship fund is administered by the Sierra Musical Arts Association.

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage musical development in young people. It is open to students of all instruments and voice who have studied music privately or in school for at least one year. Students of all levels of musical ability are eligible and are encouraged to apply. Applicants must be residents of Nevada County and in grades 5 through 12.

The Fund began giving awards in 1990 and has awarded scholarships to 46 music students since then. This spring we will be giving six awards of \$300 each.
