Our Conductor

G. "Mancho" Gonzalez, Jr. has been a respected music educator in the Sacramento area for the past 17 years. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from San Jose State University in 1975 and completed his Master in Music at CSU, Sacramento in 1995. His teaching career includes band director in elementary, junior high, and high school. He currently teaches at two elementary schools, Cosumnes River College and is the director of the River City Concert Band in Fair Oaks.

During his tenure in the public school system he served as a mentor teacher and has been a guest conductor/clinician for elementary, high school and adult bands. This is Mr. Gonzalez' second summer appearance with the Nevada County Concert Band. A trumpeter, he plays with the Newcastle Brass. He has studied wind band conducting under Gary Hill, University of Missouri/Kansas City, John Whitwell, Michigan State University, Dr. Frederick Fennel and is the first graduating wind studies master student of Robert Halseth, director of bands, CSUS.

Mr. Gonzalez has just returned from a Russia tour, conducting the Sacramento Valley Symphonic Band. He is a member of the California Music Educators Association, the California Band Directors Association, the Pacific Coast Judges Association, and a board member of the Sacramento Valley Symphonic Band Association.
