It was organized in 1990 by Mr. Gerald Willis and maintains an active schedule playing for a number of city and area events.

Our Conductors

Gerald Willis has been the musical director and conductor of the North Lake Tahoe Symphony since its inception in 1993. He is currently the director of the Sparks Community Band and the Proctor R. Hug High School Band. His school band was recently honored to represent the State of Nevada in Washington D. C. for the presidential inauguration.

Born in Southern California in 1995, Mr. Willis attended the University of Southern California and completed his music degree at CSU, Fullerton. He received his Masters of Music degree from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and is currently completing his Doctoral degree at the University of Nevada, Reno.

Michael McAllister, most recently Assistant Professor of Music at North Carolina Wesleyan College, considers Nevada City to be his home town. He began playing trumpet in the NCCB in 1970, and graduated from NUHS in 1972. He attended Sierra College before moving on to CSU, Northridge, where he completed a Bachelor of Music in Horn Performance while also studying conducting. Teaching and conducting were the ambitions that led him to the University of Southwestern Louisiana for his Master of Music in Conducting.

After ten years as Music Director at Wesleyan College, Mr. McAllister has recently accepted the position of band and choir director at Lassen High School in Susanville.
