Who's Who

Michael McAllister, most recently Assistant Professor of Music at North Carolina Wesleyan College, considers Nevada City to be his home town. He began playing trumpet in the NCCB in 1970, and graduated from NUHS in 1972. He attended Sierra College before moving on to CSU, Northridge, where he completed a Bachelor of Music in Horn Performance while also studying conducting. Teaching and conducting were the ambitions that led him to the University of Southwestern Louisiana for his Master of Music in Conducting.

After ten years as Music Director at Wesleyan College, Mr. McAllister has recently accepted the position of band and choir director at Lassen High School in Susanville.

Elizabeth McAllister graduated from Nevada Union High School in 1978, and Sierra College in 1980. She then attended California State University, Northridge, where she was a student with Dr. Charles Bay, and earned her Bachelor of Music degree in clarinet performance in 1985. Elizabeth and her husband, Michael, then accepted graduate assistantship offers, and moved to Louisiana for graduate school. While at LSU she studied with J. David Harris, and in 1987 received her Master of Music degree in clarinet performance.

Mrs. McAllister has served on the faculties of Meredith College, NC Wesleyan College, Nash Community College, and the Ravenscroft School in Raleigh, North Carolina. She is an active performer of chamber music, and has performed regularly with the Raleigh Symphony Orchestra, the Tar River Orchestra, and many other ensembles.

Elizabeth looks forward to both participating in the music activities of the area and teaching clarinet and saxophone.

Eleanor Kenitzer, volunteer director for the Grass Valley Cornish Choir as well as the GV Male Voice Choir, has been directing church and community choirs for the past 27 years. She has been serving for the last 8 years as Director of Music and Christian Education at the Grass Valley United Methodist Church.

The Grass Valley Male Voice Choir came into being after hearing the great male voice choirs in Cornwall. During the Cornish Choir's choral tour through Cornwall last September, the group was impressed with the sound of the traditional male voice choirs there, and decided that our community could/should have the same sound.... especially since the miners' choir was a Grass Valley tradition. This group, though small, has been rehearing for about 6 months and had its debut performance at the reception for the Mayor of Bodmin, Cornwall, which was held at the Holbrooke Hotel in April.

Admission to the group is by audition, and they're always looking for a "few good men"!
