Mrs. Hulda Stern established the scholarship in 1989 in memory of her husband, Emil, a long-time NCCB member known for his love and encouragement of young musicians. The purpose of the scholarship's is to encourage musical development in young people. The scholarship has been awarded to 69 music students since 1990.

#### **Our resident Conductor**

Henry Hansen's association with the band began in 1985, both as a clarinetist and as a conductor. At various times, Henry participates in other music organizations and ensembles. He has been a player in the Sierra Nevada Winds, the Twin Cities Chamber Players, the Sierra Community Symphony, the Foothill Symphony Orchestra, and the CSU-Sacramento Clarinet Choir. He has played for productions by the Foothill Theater Company, the Nevada Union Theater, and the Community Players. Henry has also organized and performed in house concerts for the Sierra Musical Arts Association.

#### What is THAT?!

Our current lead-cornet player, Mr. Greg Goodknight, often plays a very small trumpet, called a "pocket trumpet." The pocket trumpet is not a common instrument, but, nonetheless, it has been in existence for more than a century. It has the same amount of tubing as a standard trumpet but is more-tightly wrapped. Both Mr. Goodknight and Mr. Lou Travato also play cornets, which are more-highly tapered and more-tightly wrapped than a trumpet. The cornet also uses a different style mouthpiece than the trumpet and has a more-mellow tone.
