Mr. McAllister commutes to Susanville in the winter and enjoys conducting the NCCB in the summer. He serves on the faculty of McLaughlin Music Studios and is currently working on his teachers credential.

Mr. McAllister began playing trumpet in the NCCB in 1970, graduated from NUHS (Nevada Union High School) in 1972, and attended both Sierra College and California State University at Northridge. Mr. McAllister studied conducting under Dr. David Whitwell at Northridge and received a Bachelor of Music in Horn Performance.

Teaching and conducting were Mr. McAllister's two ambitions that led him to the University of Southwestern Louisiana where he received a Master of Music in conducting.

Mr. McAllister became Assistant Professor of Music at North Carolina Wesleyan College in Rocky Mount, North Carolina. During his stay in North Carolina, Mr. McAllister founded the Eastern North Carolina Wind Ensemble, which is still flourishing. After ten years as Music Director at Wesleyan, Mr. McAllister and his family returned to Nevada County.
