Growing up in Nevada County, McAllister established long-lasting ties. He played trumpet for the Nevada County Concert Band as a high school student in 1970. Throughout the years, he stayed in touch with the music group. McAllister conducted the band during several summer visits in the 1990s.

"Conducting the band is like being with old friends," McAllister said. "I'm a big believer in community music."

McAllister still feels the same amount of pride in the concert band as he did in the '70s.
