The band performs free concerts throughout the year for many events such as the Fourth of July and Constitution Day parades. This year, the band is presenting four concerts in honor of California's Sesquicentennial celebration of statehood in conjunction with our annual Pioneer Park Picnic Pops Concerts each month June through September.
