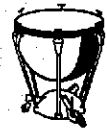
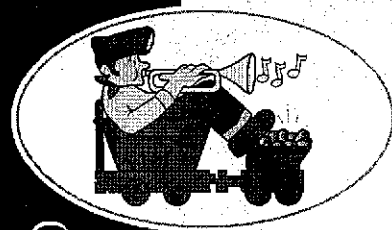

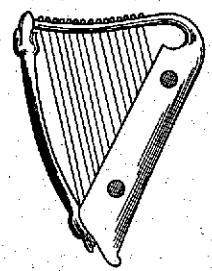

The Nevada County Concert Band began in the 1850's as an all-brass band of Cornish miners and their families and developed into what it is today, a group of 45 community volunteers of varying backgrounds with differing levels of musical experience whose ages range from young students in their teens to middle-aged working people to older retirees.

Under the baton for the past seven years of its director Henry Hansen, the band is well known locally for its rousing performances of Sousa marches and popular show music. Mr. Hansen is particularly proud of the band's continuing musical development in an ever-expanding repertoire of historical folk music.

The band performs free concerts throughout the year for many events, such as the Fourth of July and Constitution Day parades. This year, in conjunction with its annual Pioneer Picnic Pops Concerts in the months from June through September, the band is presenting four concerts in honor of California's Sequicentennial celebration of statehood.

## CONDUCTOR - HENRY HANSEN

Henry Hansen's association with the band began in 1985 as a conductor and clarinetist. Henry continues to participate in other music organizations and ensembles. He has been a player in the Sierra Nevada Winds, the Twin Cities Chamber Players, the Sierra Community Symphony, the Foothill Symphony Orchestra, and the CSU-Sacramento Clarinet Choir. He has played for productions by the Foothill Theater Company, the Nevada Union Theater, and the Community Players. Henry has also organized and performed in house concerts for the Sierra Musical Arts Association.

## CONCERT ANNOUNCER - JACK STEWART

In addition to being a clarinetist, Jack Stewart is also the Voice of the NCCB, adding his sometimes ribald, usually humorous, but always informative commentary to our programs.

Jack has been involved with the band since 1987. After playing in some school groups, Jack became a member of the Tenth Olympiad Band for the 1932 Los Angeles Olympic Games. This Olympiad Band was a synthesis of four, smaller, 50-piece bands: band **A** consisted of professional musicians, bands **B** and **C** were high school volunteers, and band **D** consisted of members from the Pasadena Jr. College Band. Jack played in band **C**.

In 1955, after a 20 year hiatus, Jack joined the Aahmes (Oakland) Shrine Temple band. He later played in the Castro Valley Community Band, followed by the Walnut Creek Concert Band, and, finally, by the Nevada County Concert Band.
