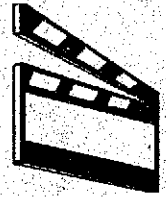
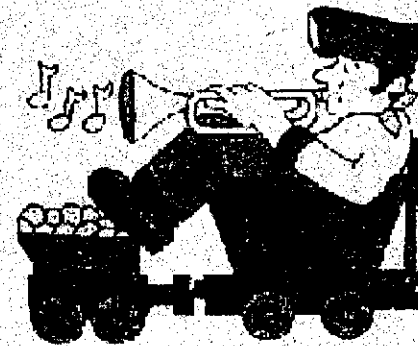

## Our Conductor

**M**r. McAllister is the former Band Director at Placer High School in Auburn, California and prior to that time served as an assistant professor of music at Carolina Wesleyan College in Rocky Mount, North Carolina.

A local resident, Mr. McAllister began playing trumpet in the Nevada County Concert Band in 1970, and graduated from Nevada Union High School in 1972. He attended Sierra College before moving on to California State University at Northridge where he completed a Bachelor of Music in Horn Performance. Teaching and conducting were the ambitions that led him to the University of Southwestern Louisiana where he received a Master of Music in conducting.

While in North Carolina Mr. McAllister founded the Eastern North Carolina Wind Ensemble which is still flourishing. After ten years as Music Director at Wesleyan, Mr. McAllister and his family returned to Nevada County. He not only is an active conductor of the Nevada County Concert Band; but, also serves as a music performance instructor on the faculty of McLaughlin Music Studios.

**J**im Kerr is a graduate of San Jose State University with a BA in Philosophy. After graduation he served in the Air Force. Over his 20 years of service Mr. Kerr saw duty in Ohio, Vietnam, Thailand, Virginia, Germany and finally California.
