In addition to being the conductor of the Nevada County Concert Band, Cheryl is a member of the Sierra Symphony, teaches music privately, plays occasionally with the Auburn Symphony and substitute teaches throughout the Nevada County school district. Cheryl is also the Music Instructor (strings and youth orchestra) at Yuba River Charter School and owns a small music publishing company, Bronze:FX. She is a member of the professional group Sonos Handbell Ensemble, which is internationally acclaimed and tours regularly as well as performing with her trio Serenades in Harmony at local weddings/events. Cheryl and her two children live in Grass Valley.
