Cheryl (Sutton) Baker is an accomplished choral, hand bell, and orchestral conductor, as well as a vocalist, published composer, and hand bell clinician. She has been a church music director in the San Francisco Bay Area, and is the past-director of the community ensemble Bay Bells which toured California, Oregon, Nevada, New Mexico, Hawaii and Indonesia.

Cheryl holds a Bachelors of Music degree in Church Music from Westminster Choir College (Princeton NJ), with her principle instrument as voice, and a minor in organ, and plays many instruments. In addition to being the conductor of the Nevada County Concert Band, Cheryl is a member of the Sierra Symphony, teaches music privately, and substitute teaches throughout the Nevada County school district. Cheryl is also the conductor of the Auburn Community Band, serves on the Area XII Board of the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers (AGEHR), and owns a small music publishing company, Bronze:FX. Cheryl and her two children live in Grass Valley.

Jim Kerr is a graduate of San Jose State University with a BA in Philosophy. After graduation he served in the Air Force. Over his 20 years of service, Mr. Kerr saw duty in Ohio, Vietnam, Thailand, Virginia, Germany and finally California. His expertise in intelligence through imagery interpretation has seen him connected to SAC, NATO, NORAD and the SR-71 Program at Beale AFB.
