Cheryl has been directing this band since 2000. She is an accomplished choral, handbell, and orchestral conductor, published composer, singer, and plays many instruments. She is the past director of the community handbell ensemble Bay Bells, and performs and records regularly with the internationally acclaimed Sonos Handbell Ensemble. Cheryl is proprietor for the music publishing company Bronze:FX, plays occasionally with the Auburn Symphony, and teaches music at the Yuba River Charter School, Nevada Union High School, and will be starting a music program at Clear Creek School this fall. She is a graduate of Westminster Choir College (Princeton, N.J.), has two children in college, and has recently completed her California teaching credential.

Jim Kerr, the "voice of western Nevada County," retired from KNCO Newstalk 83 last summer after 18 years—a second career that followed 20 years as a US Air Force intelligence officer. After settling in Grass Valley, Jim applied for a part-time disc jockey job at KNCO in 1987, eventually becoming the morning host, programmer, and news director.
