## JOIN OUR BAND!

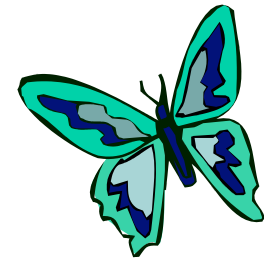

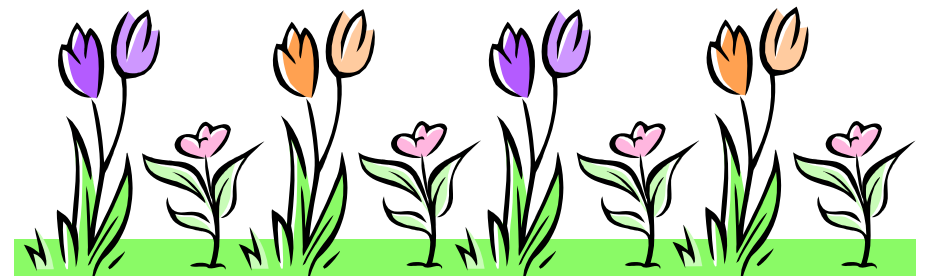

She holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Church Music from Westminster Choir College (Princeton, NJ), with a major in voice and a minor in organ, although she plays many other instruments, too. She has been the music director for several churches in the San Francisco Bay Area and is the past director of the community handbell ensemble, Bay Bells ([www.baybells.org](http://www.baybells.org)). Cheryl has served many years at the national and local levels within the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers ([www.agehr.org](http://www.agehr.org)), is an active member of the professional handbell ensemble Sonos ([www.sonos.org](http://www.sonos.org)), and often sits in with the Auburn Symphony ([www.auburnsymphony.com](http://www.auburnsymphony.com)). She teaches music privately and at several local K-8 schools, and she substitute teaches throughout the Nevada County school district. Cheryl is a member of the music fraternity Sigma Alpha Iota, and also owns Bronze:FX, a music publishing company ([www.bronzefx.com](http://www.bronzefx.com)). Cheryl and her family live in Grass Valley, CA.
