one time, and you might be up on stage for the next concert. Most of us have found that you really can come back to music after a long break, and it's just pure fun. Nice people, too!

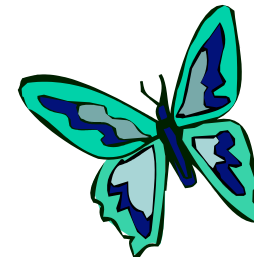

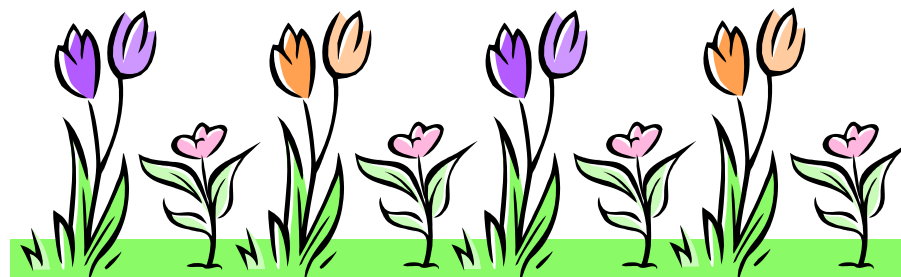
