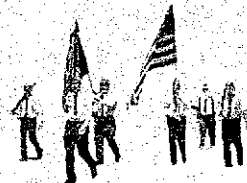

"DINK" AND DAVE RIFE

Dink & Dave moved to Portola in 1964. Dave began teaching and coaching at Portola High School and Dink gave birth to their first daughter, Robin. Twenty months later they had a second daughter, Renee.



Dave continued teaching science and P.E. at PHS for 30 years. He coached football, basketball, track, skiing, & tennis. One of those years he spent obtaining a Masters Degree and another year

as an exchange teacher in Wales. Dink worked for 20 years with the disabled in Plumas County and as a teacher/counselor in the Portola schools. Besides being involved in all the school activities, Dave and Dink were active in the Plumas Ski Club, the Portola Booster Club and the Graeagle Tennis Club. He and Dink were ski instructors for the school ski program in Johnsville for 32 years and Dave was the director of the program for 10 years.

In the 48 years of living and raising a family in Portola and Graeagle (they moved to Graeagle in 1997), the Rifes have been actively involved in many volunteer activities. These activities include the EPCAN food pantry, Plumas Eureka State Park, White Sulphur Springs Ranch Restoration and the Neighborhood Watch Program. They initiated placing memorial benches around the Mill Pond and are still actively involved in doing more. They do fund-raising and purchasing of sports' equipment for Project Santa Claus. Both are active hikers, skiers, tennis and golf players. Dink is also active with the Hard Core Hikers, Hospice, EPHC Advisory Council and EPHC Auxiliary Scholarship Committee, Mohawk Community Resource Center, and the Mohawk Valley Independence Day Committee. She is the poet for the published children's books: The Graeagle Bear, Graeagle Bear's Winter Adventures, and Spring Is In The Air With Graeagle Bear. She is also a member of Beta Sigma-Phi Sorority.

Dink and Dave feel they work as a team on all volunteer activities. Dink feels that Dave is her "silent partner" and is really the "wind beneath her wings" with their community involvement. They feel flattered to have been chosen Grand Marshals for the 2012 MVID Parade.

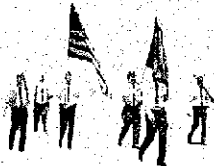

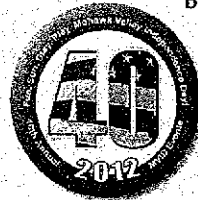
PLUMAS EUREKA

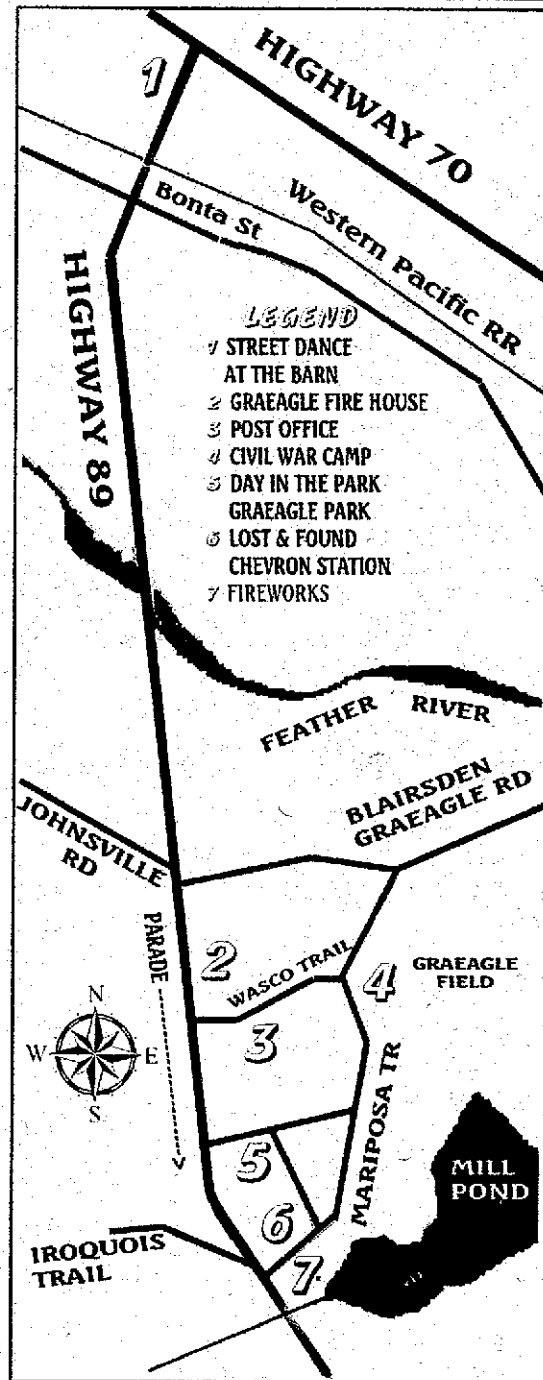
