Cheryl (Sutton, Baker) Woldseth is an accomplished conductor, performer, clinician, and educator. She teaches music/drama at several local schools, is a member of the music fraternity Sigma Alpha Iota, and owns Bronze:FX, a music publishing company. Cheryl lives in Grass Valley, CA.
