Transfer to airport for check-in

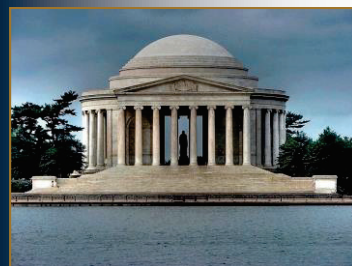
