Cheryl (Sutton, Baker) Woldseth is an accomplished conductor, performer, clinician, and educator. She holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Church Music from Westminster Choir College (Princeton, NJ), with a major in voice and minor in organ, although she plays many other instruments, too. She is the past director of church music and community handbell ensembles in the SF Bay Area, and a past officer of Handbell Musicians of America. She is a professional member of the Sonos Handbell Ensemble, and performs locally with the Raspberry Jam Band. She teaches music/drama at several local schools, is a member of the music fraternity Sigma Alpha Iota, and owns Bronze:FX, a music publishing company. Cheryl lives in Grass Valley, CA.
